



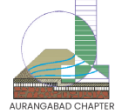
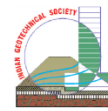

## Title of Your Abstract for IGC2024 Conference

### Abstract

This abstract provides important instructions related to the format to be used when submitting the initial abstract to the IGC 2024 conference. The abstract should be 300 words or less. The margins should be 1” on all sides. Type font should be Times New Roman 12 Point and justified. The title should appear at the top in 14 Point, centered, and in bold. The authors’ names should appear below the title and centered. Each author’s name should appear as a first name, middle name (if applicable) and last name. The primary author should be the first author. A superscript numeral should designate the author’s organization. For each separate organization, the superscript numeral should appear reflecting the author’s organization. The authors’ organization details and address must be given in the page footer. It is preferred that your abstract talks about topic’s introduction, background, research method, results, conclusion and recommendation.

The email address of the primary author must be provided in the footer. The e-mail address should be double-checked since it will be used as the primary means of contacting the authors.

The abstract must be submitted in pdf format. At the end of abstract, two to four keywords should be provided. Keywords are a tool to help indexers and search engines find relevant papers.
